Grant Application Rubric

Question 1: General Grant Request: How does your grant request address a need in your classroom (school) and enrich the scholars' learning experience. The grant should identify the targeted scholars and the impact the grant will have on the learning experience.

- 1: The answer identifies the need and how the plan will broadly address the solution.
- 2: The answer mentions need and loosely explains the solution. Lacks explanation in deeper details and how the plan will change the learning environment.
- 3: The answer mentions the need and clearly explains it and how the plan will solve the needs. Does not provide elevated detail or concrete examples on how the grant will address the need.
- 4: The answer clearly explains the issue and how the plan will address need and provides concrete examples. The project can be easily replicated and impact many scholars.

Question 2: SIT and WSFCS Strategic Plan Alignment: If grant is approved how will the grant align with School Improve Team and WSFCS Strategic Plans?

- 1: The answer mentions the alignment; however, does not explain how they were determined or how the plan will meet its target.
- 2: The answer explains a process to align with the Strategic Plans.
- 3: The answer explains both the process and determination on how the plan align with Strategic Plans without giving details or examples.
- 4: The answer explains both the process and determination on how the plan align with school and district plans. It provides examples, inputs and projected goals.

Question 3: Grant -Specific. Does the application show their understanding of the specific grant?

- 1: The answer shows a basic level of understanding and existing resources but not specify how they will be utilized.
- 3: The answer demonstrates explicitly how specific, and resources are to be utilized. The project will have a long-term impact on the scholars' learning experience.

Bonus point:

- 1: The grant highlights creativity and engaging scholars. If the reviewer was a scholar in this class, would you benefit from this project?

4. *List individually all items/services to be purchased, not to exceed \$1,500. How will your project be sustained after the initial grant allocation.
